Activities

Activity 1: Spider Candy Cones

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

- 🕷️ Ice Cream Cones
- 🕷️ Black PomPom (small and large)
- 🕷️ 2 Wiggle Eyes
- 🕷️ Black Chenille Stems
- 🕷️ Black Pony Beads
- 🕷️ Saran Wrap
- 🕷️ Candy
- 🕷️ Chocolate

Methods:

- 🕷️ Glue the small head pompom to the large head pompom.
- 🕷️ Glue wiggle eyes to the head.
- 🕷️ Glue one pony bead to the end of each of the 8 chenille stems
- 🕷️ Make a bend in the top of the chenille stem and then glue to the underside of the spider so that there are 4 stems on each side.
- 🕷️ Dip the ice cream cones in chocolate.
- 🕷️ Allow to dry and then add candy.
- 🕷️ Wrap in saran wrap.
- 🕷️ Attach spider








Activity 2: Trick or Treat Bags

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Brown bags
-  Black Paint
-  Orange Paint
-  White Paint
-  Halloween Stamps
-  Paint brushes
-  Cups of water
-  Paper towels
-  Glitter, stickers, glue (optional)

Methods:

-  Have the students pick a bag.
-  Brush the paint on the stamps
-  Stamp onto the bags.
-  Repeat with desired stamps and designs.
-  Glitter if time allows.





Activity 3: Spider Pencils



Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Pencils
-  Black PomPom (small and large)
-  2 Wiggle Eyes
-  Black Chenille Stems

Methods:

-  Cut pipe cleaners into 4 short strips.
-  Glue the pipe cleaners to the pencils.

-  Glue the small head pompom to the large head pompom and then onto the pencil above the pipe cleaners.
-  Glue wiggle eyes to the head.





Activity 4: Witch's Hat

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Oreos
-  Orange Frosting
-  Hershey Kisses

Methods:

-  Using the icing as glue, glue the Hershey's kiss to the Oreo cookie.
-  Using the icing, make a ribbon around the Oreo. The result should look like a hat.



Activity 5: Spooky Cupcakes



Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Icing
-  Sprinkles
-  Cupcakes

Methods:

-  Bake the cupcakes



-  Ice the cupcakes
-  Add sprinkles



Activity 6: Spooky Cookies

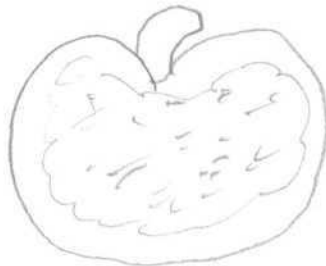
Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Cookies (in the shape of Halloween creatures)
-  Icing
-  Sprinkles

Methods:



-  Have the children choose 2 cookies.
-  Ice and decorate with sprinkles.







Activity 7: Witch Door Corner Craft

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Pre-cut foam shapes
-  Hot glue gun

Methods:

-  Glue the yellow moon behind black witch body
-  Glue face to black witch body and then glue hair to the face
-  Glue orange rickrack trim to hat
-  Glue small wiggle eyes to bat and then glue the bat to the yellow

moon

- Glue foam hands to ends of arms
- Glue stem to pumpkin and then glue to witch's hand



Activity 8: Egg Shaped Characters

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

- Plastic Eggs
- Glue gun
- Pre-cut foam shapes
- Wiggle eyes

Methods:

- To make the cat:
 1. Glue egg to black heart base
 2. Glue felt ears, wiggle eyes, and pink foam nose to the egg
 3. Curl one end of the black chenille stem and glue to the back side of the cat
 4. Cut one white chenille stem in half and then bend the two pieces in half to make the cat whiskers and glue to the egg
 5. Glue orange bow to front of egg
- To make the mummy:
 1. Glue egg to green heart base
 2. Wrap felt strips around egg and glue in place. 12 strips per egg
 3. Leave space for wiggle eyes and glue them to the egg
 4. Glue felt hands to the side of the egg



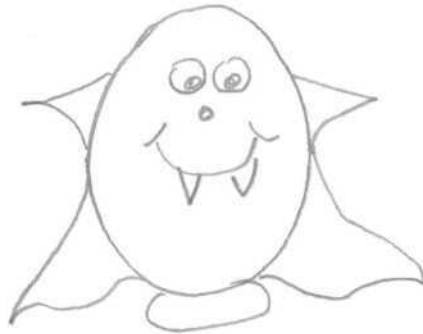
To make the Dracula:

1. Glue egg to black heart base
2. Glue wiggle eyes and bow to the front of the egg
3. Glue cape and cape collar around the egg



To make the witch:




1. Glue egg to black heart base
2. Glue yarn hair (16 pcs.) and bangs (4 pcs.) to the top of the egg. Pieces may be cut to various lengths.
3. Glue two felt hat pieces together. Allow to dry and then turn inside out. Fold one edge up and glue into place. Glue checked patch to hat and then glue to head.
4. Glue satin bow to front of egg.







Activity 9: Fall Leaves Door Hanger

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

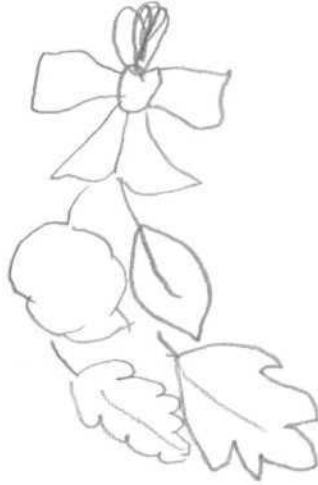
Materials:

-  Pre-cut foam leaves
-  Ribbon
-  Jute String

Methods:

-  Tie one leaf of each color to the string
-  String two beads on each jute string
-  Tie a knot after the first bead and then string the second bead
-  Gather all of the strings together and adjust the length

- Tie a knot in the top to secure and cut the longer ends off
- Glue the fabric bow over the knot and then glue the smaller bows to each string as shown.



Activity 10: Candy Corn Door Hanger

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

- Candy Corn Foam Shapes
- Ribbon
- Jute String
- Beads

Methods:




- Prepare the foam candy corns in advance.
- Tie a piece of jute string to each candy corn. String three beads to each piece of jute string, tying a knot between the beads
- Stagger the candy corn and then make a loop at the top and tie
- Glue the fabric bows on each string.






Activity 11: Sunflower Pin Craft Kit

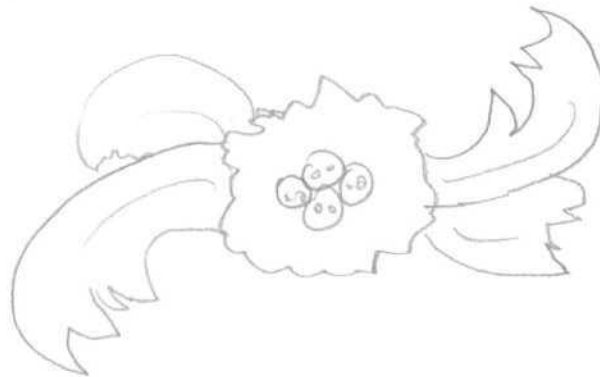
Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Pre-cut foam shapes
-  Hot glue gun
-  Pins

Methods:

-  Glue one dark yellow button to the center of the flower
-  Glue three yellow and three brown buttons around the center button
-  Glue the sunflower to the leaf and then glue the pin to the back of the leaf




Activity 12: Foam Halloween Pins

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Precut foam shapes
-  Glue gun
-  Wiggle eyes
-  Pins

Methods:

-  Make the ghost, cat, and pumpkin pins







Activity 13: M & M's Graph Activity

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions, to solve multiplication problems, to graph

Materials:

-  M & M's
-  Crayons

Methods:

-  Guess the number of M & M's in the bag
-  Count the actual number of M & M's
-  Solve several multiplication problems
-  Graph your results



Activity 14: Ghost Windsocks

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Two 9"x 12" White Craft Foam
-  1/2 Piece Black Craft Foam
-  Low Temp Glue Gun
-  Hole Punch
-  Stapler or Brass Fasteners
-  White String
-  White Plastic Bag (we used half of a tall kitchen bag)

Methods:



🍎 Cut a plastic bag into 1" to 2" strips. Cut a ghostly face out of black craft foam. Glue it to the middle of one piece of white craft foam. Turn foam face upside down and glue strips of plastic bag all along the bottom edge of both pieces of foam.

🍎 Staple or fasten sides of foam together to make into the ghost head. Punch a hole in each side. Add a string to hang.

Activity 15: Popcorn Hands

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions,

Materials:

- 🍎 Popcorn
- 🍎 Candy corn
- 🍎 Gloves
- 🍎 String

Methods:

- 🍎 Have the children pop the popcorn
- 🍎 Place candy corn in the fingertips of the gloves
- 🍎 Fill with popcorn
- 🍎 Tie with ribbon







Activity 16: Ghost pops

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Tissue
-  Orange Yarn
-  Lollipop
-  Black Marker

Methods:

-  Have the children select the lollipop
-  Wrap it with white kleenex
-  Tie with string
-  Color on eyes





Activity 17: Halloween Puzzles



Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions,

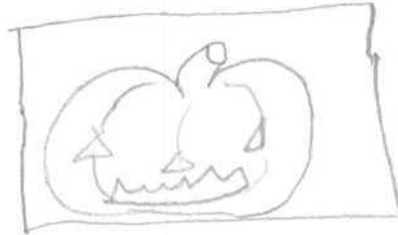
Materials:

-  Puzzle
-  Construction Paper
-  Glue
-  Scissors
-  Crayons

Methods:

-  Have the children color the puzzle
-  Glue the puzzle to a piece of construction paper

-  Cut the puzzle up
-  Try to put the puzzle together








Activity 18: Pumpkin Buddy

Objective: to improve reading comprehension, to improve the ability to follow directions

Materials:

-  Pumpkin picture
-  Orange Construction Paper
-  Crayons
-  Glue
-  Scissors
-  Scissors

Methods:

-  Have the children color their pumpkin
-  Cut it out
-  Cut the orange construction paper into 1 inch by 12 inches
-  Fold the strips in an accordion like manner
-  Glue to the pumpkin to form arms and legs
